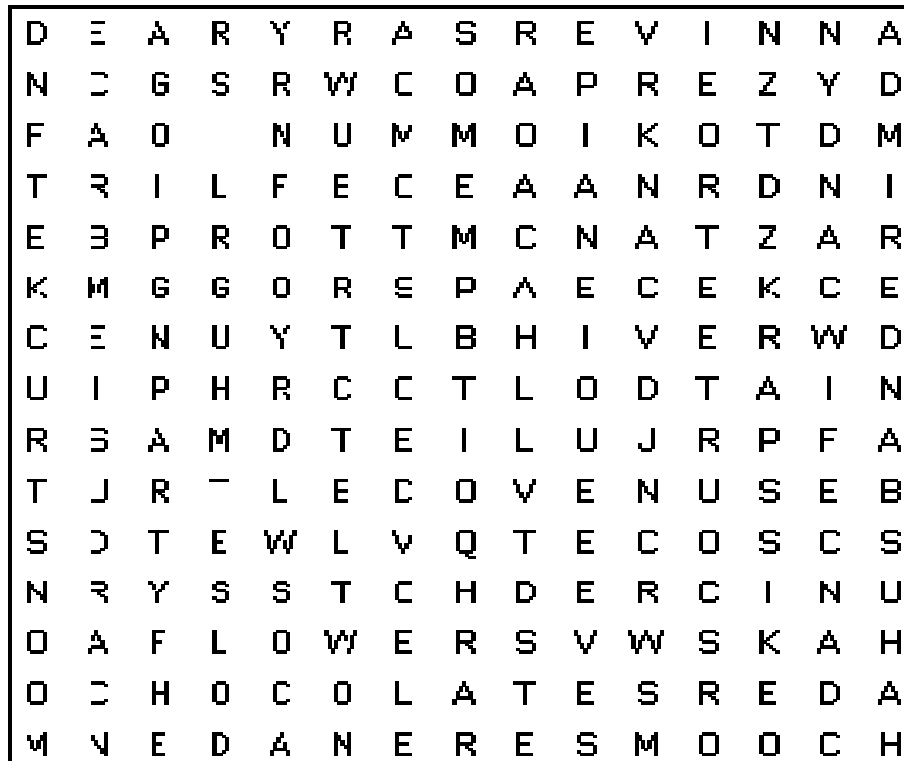


45 ways (because 50 wouldn't fit) to get rid of a bad date:
