

Industries with Most Turnover Last Year

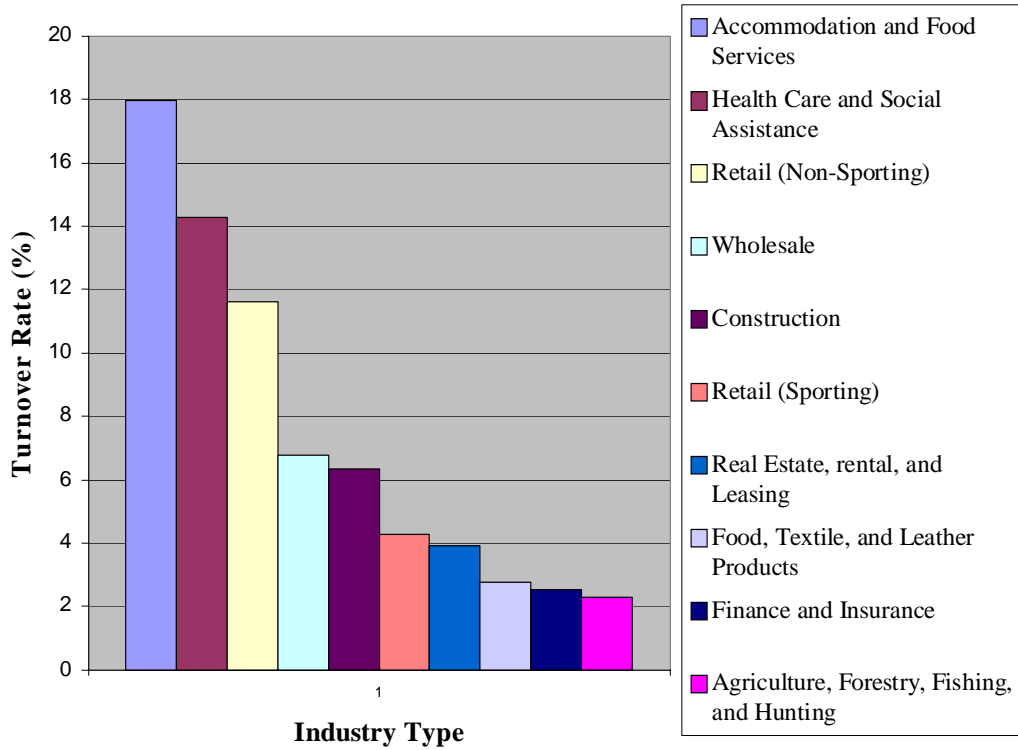


Figure 7. Industries with the highest turnover rate in the last 12 months (Minimum 30 occupational observations)

To have a better picture of the turnover situation in the region, the study calculated which industries in the region had occupations with the highest turnover rates (Table 11/ Figure 7). Of course, many industries are likely to include the same high turnover occupations, so the findings below represent the distribution of high turnover occupations across industries in the region.
