

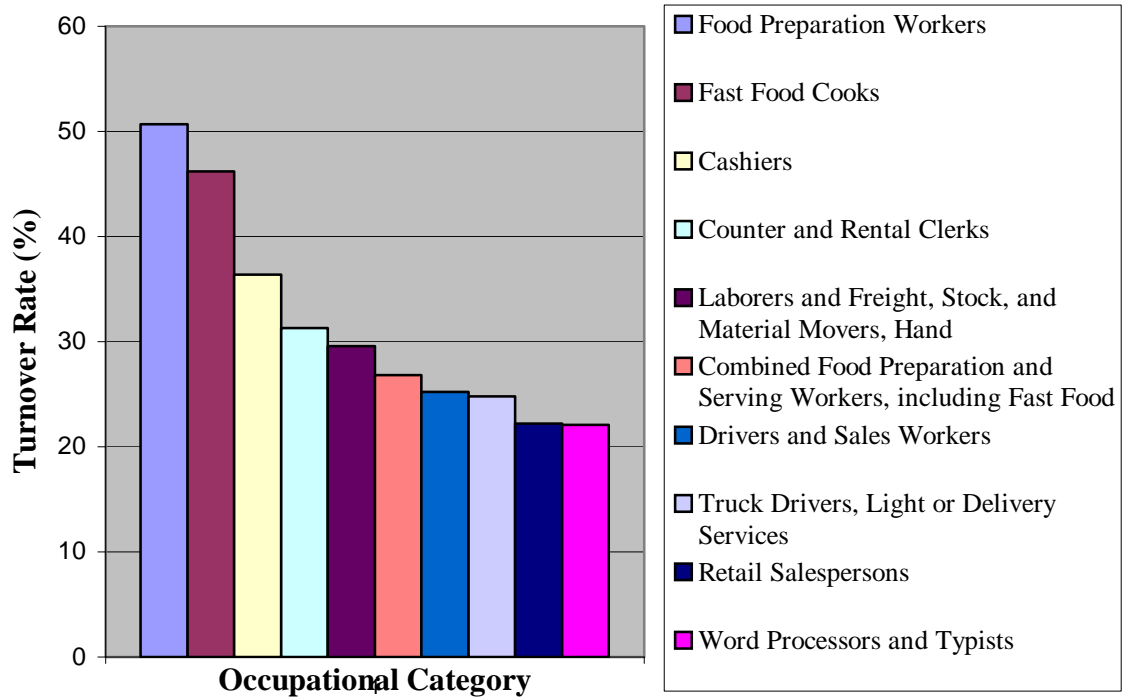
## Occupations with Most Turnover Last Year

---

Based on the responses received, the survey identified the following 10 occupations with highest average turnover: food preparation workers (50.7 percent), fast food cooks (46.2 percent), cashiers (36.4 percent), counter and rental clerks (31.3 percent), laborers and freight, stock, and materials movers, hand (29.6 percent), combined food preparation and serving workers, including fast food (26.8 percent), drivers, sales workers (25.2 percent), truck drivers, light or delivery services (24.8 percent), retail salespersons (22.2 percent), and word processors and typists (22.1 percent).
