

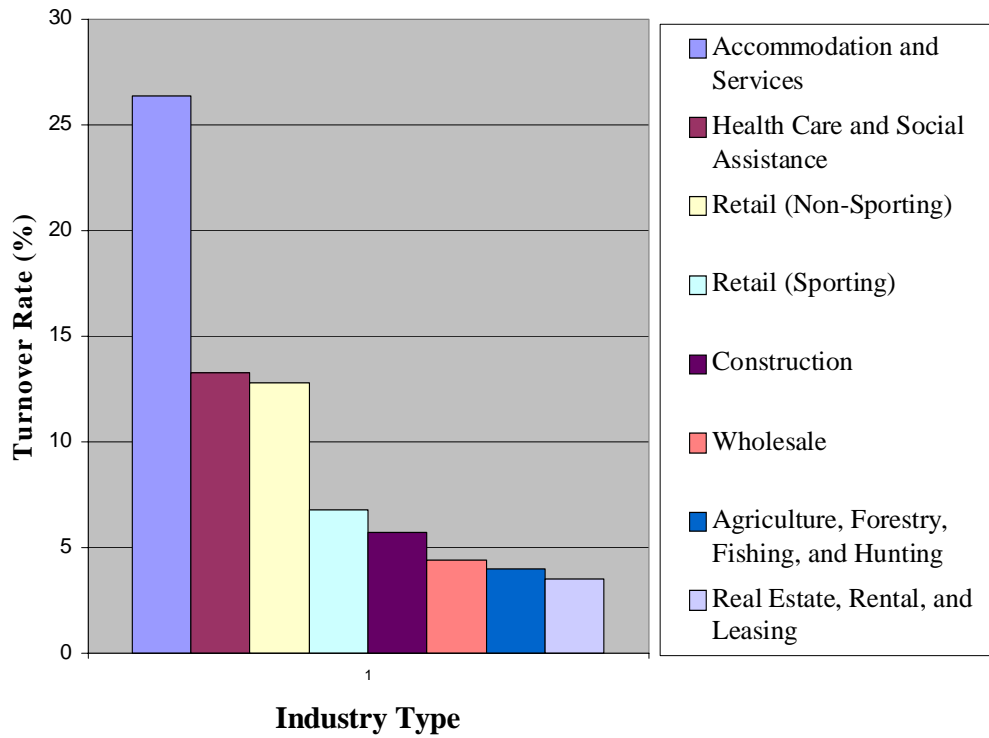
## Industries with Most Expected Turnover Next Year

---

The survey also asked respondents to forecast expected turnover for particular occupations in the next 12 months. As shown in Table 13 (Figure 9), industries employing occupations with the highest average turnover rates will most likely be the ones that also had the highest turnover rates last year: accommodation and food services (26.35 percent), health care and social assistance (13.26 percent), retail-nonsporting (12.79 percent), retail-sporting (6.74 percent), construction (5.68 percent), wholesale (4.42 percent), agriculture, forestry, fishing, and hunting (3.96 percent), and real estate, rental, and leasing (3.49 percent).
